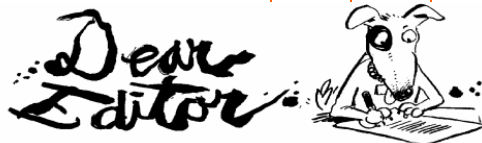

VHOC 50th Annual Obedience, Agility & Rally Trials

A message from Laurie Burnam, VHOC Obedience Trial Chair

To all club members, their family and friends:

Please, please, we need all the help we can get to pull off setting up rings on Thursday, a match on Friday, 2 full days of agility, obedience and rally, and then putting everything away on Sunday late afternoon. Call me or E-mail back ASAP where you would like to help out. This is an enormous task but with a lot of help we won't kill ourselves. If everyone has a specific task then the day runs smoothly. Thursday: *Load & unload equipment on the truck. (Aaron & Cindi Malchose will pick up the truck at the rental place, drive to the storage locker, load equipment, then drive to the chair rental place, load chairs and bring everything to Woodley Park). We need at least 3 or 4 helpers who will then help as follows:*

Set up 3 obedience rings and 1 rally ring with rebar and white chains; place jumps and any other items needed near rings.

Friday: *Match—See Sandy Walton. Agility rings set up — See Kim Simons & Moira Cornell*

Saturday & Sunday: *Obedience/Rally Judges and Stewards Hospitality. This year we will have a separate eating/relaxing tent for the 4 Judges and 15 Stewards only. This job is to make sure they have coffee, tea, muffins, water etc. in the tent and at ring side, and help them get their lunches and whatever else they might need. There should be 2 or more people on this task.*

General Hospitality: *Make sure the coffee/tea pots are filled, breakfast items are out and all the fixings available. Clean up the mess as it accumulates. The workers and entrants are allowed to eat and drink from here. We need 2 people working here.*

Catalog Sales: *Carole Raschella, Catalog Chair will need 2 people moving around the crowd, selling catalogs to everyone. This is a good money maker for the club. We need someone who is friendly but with enough force to get them to buy. These people can also sell the raffle tickets to the crowd.*

Raffle Set-Up: *Jan Slotar, Raffle Chair will need 4 people to organize the items on the table, sell tickets, then hand out the items to the winners. This may be on Saturday only.*

Lunches: *Nancy Giltner, Food Chair will need 4 people to help put out the lunches, condiments and utensils and help serve the lunches/drinks to the exhibitors and workers.*

Trophy: *Sarah Sykes, Trophy Chair will need 2 people to set up the trophy display and organize the items then hand them out to the winners at the end of each day. Also, hand out the ribbons and prizes to each ring as needed when the class is completed.*

Rally Course Set-Up: *We may need a couple of people to help the judge set up the rally course each day—unless one of the hired stewards does this job.*

Sunday Break-Down: *Take down all the rings, equipment, EZ ups, etc. and load the truck. Return equipment to storage and chair rental. General clean up of everything. This is for all the venues so we will need a zillion bodies to help.*

Margarita-Maker (or Hot Toddies): *Depending on the weather, after 4 days of this mess we will all need something to celebrate with — maybe we will have to stay in Moira's RV. Hey...that might be fun!*

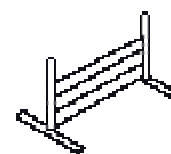
