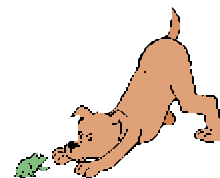

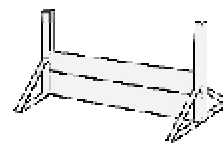

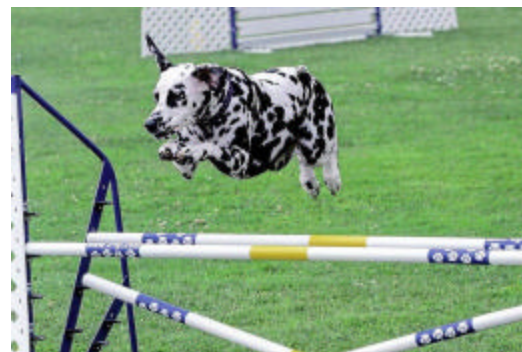

The 'Gone With The Wind' Show!

Thanks to Pam Kidd for sharing an excerpt from her story and to Carole Raschella for the accompanying photo.

Carole Raschella was very lucky that the tents stayed grounded just long enough for her Gordon, Dickens (Amberlove Best of Times), to be awarded Winners Dog for a four point major at the GSCA Palm Springs specialty. Winners Bitch was also selected, but the show was cancelled due to damaging winds before further judging could be completed. Thank you to Carole for taking the time to forward an "on the scene" report which was written by event attendee and "freckled setter" fancier, Pam Kidd. Pam skillfully captured the experience from her vantage point that day as the Inland Empire English Setter Club Specialty Chair. The English Setter puppy sweeps were taking place at the same time as the GSCA specialty.

The following is an excerpt from Pam's article ("*IEESC January 2007 Specialty GONE at 80 MPH!*") beginning with Pam's observations during the English Setter sweepstakes.

The Sweeps event was challenging for sure—the ring steward could barely give out arm bands without the wind ripping them out of her hand. The ribbons had to be kept boxed as did the trophies. Dogs were standing wide in front to give them balance in the wind and our sweeps judge, Laura Reynolds, was doing a heck of a job going over the windblown dogs while holding down her skirt with such style! You could see the tent tops billowing up and the guywires starting to sag.

At about 11 a.m., the Gordon Setters in the ring to our left were wrapping up the final class and the Irish Setters on our right were finishing up Veteran Sweeps when the winds hit in 70 to 80 mph gusts. Has the expression "All hell was breaking loose" come to mind? It did to us!!! People starting yelling "the large circus tent is giving way." Sure enough, the stakes were pulling out of the ground and WHAM--the 14' x 14' tent that extends from the main tent into the ring flipped and landed in the middle of the Gordon ring! Were there dogs or people under it? Thank goodness there weren't! It landed in the middle of the go around!

The winds became stronger and were persistent--the tents continued to billow and stakes pulled out of the ground like toothpicks out of a cake.

Cables buckled and the ring tent was soon lying upside down like a dying spider, while everyone was trying to escape. People were running with their dogs and whatever else they could carry. We pulled our dogs out--luckily they were crated and on the carts. We grabbed what we could and started pulling our dogs to safety...or were we??? As we pushed and pulled the dogs through the ring and out from under the main tent to the adjacent grooming tent, we realized those tents were in jeopardy too!

People banded together, pulling other people's crates out, grabbing gear, etc.--it didn't matter what breed—just GET THE DOGS TO SAFETY! The main tent started tearing and the legs were bouncing with every gust. "RUN! GET OUT" was the cry!

After we could find no other dogs or people in harm's way within the main tent area, it was time to get out from under the false safety of the grooming tent as it was starting to tear apart fast! We headed for the RV with the first of many loads. You could see the tents flipping half way over but not quite all the way--what a sight, one that I hope I will never see again. After a few more trips from the show field to the RV's and getting items back to their rightful owners, we started to feel a sense of relief.

The grounds were now closed to all exhibitors; a few people remained at the site to help the Kennel Club of Palm Springs' staff secure the grounds until the Indio Police Department arrived and took over.

Crew members then did a spectacular job, working throughout the night to remove all the damaged tents and debris. And after a slight delay, at 10:00am the next morning, under sunny, balmy skies, the show reopened with the playing of the National Anthem.

As Pam aptly put it, "Life goes on—as it should."



Say No to AB 1634

AB 1634 requires that all dogs and be spayed or neutered by four months of age unless the dog qualifies for a special permit. Many working dogs in California would not qualify. If all these working dogs are spayed or neutered, then they would become extinct.

Save Our Dogs' is an effort by a small group of people to spread the word of how AB 1634 will hurt working dogs in California. Most pet dog owners are not familiar with working dogs and so are not aware of the harm this bill would do if it becomes law. 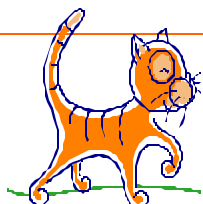
