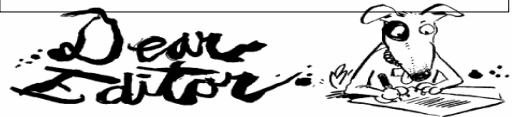

At the Western WA Weim club specialty the day before the National, he earned a judge's AOM! The entry was close to 100 Weims and only 4 AOMs were given out. And we did it all Breeder/Owner/Handled! I'm quite proud of my boy!

Grace lost to a Rottweiler, though first and second were a Flat-Coat Retriever and a Golden (at the San Diego Basset Hound Specialty that had all-breed obedience!) about two hours from here in Orange County. Grace is 8 1/2+, and will go on to Utility, though she'll probably spend the next several months on Rally while she polishes for Utility.

As for why I didn't go...well, we are supposed to be having really hot weather, and so we arranged for a pet-sitter to let the other dogs out, but the pet sitter's significant other ended up in the hospital, so she couldn't do it, AND the real reason I didn't go, and we didn't want to take the rest of the pack was because on the judging schedule it read, 'Beware of Rattlesnakes! And we mean it!' Yeah, like I wanted to take all 4 Boxers and have to deal with that possibility plus temps. in the upper '90's! YIKES! And yes, Scott took a working wet coat; 'Go-Dog' (electrolytes); a fan; a spray bottle; lots of treats and lots of water. It was close to an 8 hour day for him and Grace. Alas, he didn't get a video or a photograph, and expected the I-5 to be a parking lot, so it took more than a few hours to get back home (80 miles).

This was Grace's best overall score in open (though he said her heeling was a bit ragged due to the heat, her other exercises were good - groups were in the shade), and we are very proud of our plain 'Gracie-Face' (that nickname is compliments of Betty Aikenhead), or as she's sometimes known, 'just plain Grace.'

Well, after earning advanced titles in herding and agility, I FINALLY brought him out in obedience at the ASCA show May 16 & 17.

In his Novice B debut, among some great working dogs and in 103E temperature, he earned a 199.5 and went HIT. On Sunday (105E), he earned a perfect 200 and HIT for his second leg. As we finished, the judge said "That was scrumptious!" When it came time for pictures, she brought out her own personal camera and took a picture for her scrapbook, saying she'd only given two 200s in nearly 50 years of judging!

The event was even more special because my obedience and herding trainers and many fellow VHOC buddies were there to see it, plus my agility friends who have never seen him work in obedience. Thanks to all those who cheered Trooper on!

I had Trace entered in agility across the way. My herding instructor showed him in the early classes and he got his first Novice Gamblers leg, 1st place with her (after he stopped looking for sheepies!). I showed him later that day but couldn't Q to save my life—I wonder why? But who cares!! :-)

One funny moment: We were camped at the site, Antelope Valley Fairgrounds. Saturday night, we let a group of dogs run and play on the grounds. If you could have seen Trooper's face when he crossed the parking lot that separated agility and obedience and saw the agility equipment (he hadn't been allowed to peek!)—he looked back at me accusingly: "THERE'S AGILITY HERE!???", he seemed to say! Priceless!

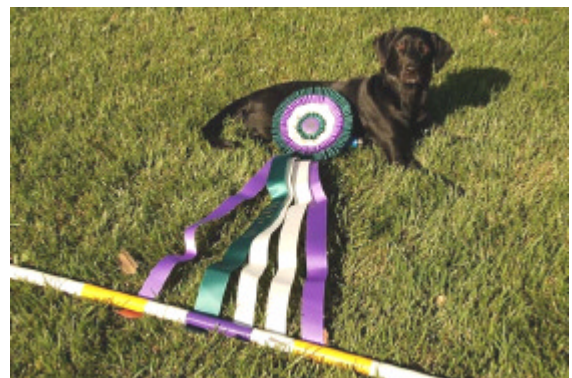

The board meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Nancy Giltner. Board members, Lindia Brown, Laurie Burnam, Moira Cornell, Ann Hills, Carole Hills, Cindi Malchose, Allison Pobirs, Patti Rovtar, Kim Simons, Christy Tattersall, Sandy Walton and Linda Zimmerman were in attendance. Linda Brooks attended as a guest. The Minutes were approved and the Treasurer's report was presented.

**General Membership Meeting Committee:** Lindia Brown submitted a request that the Board vote on and approve a motion to hold general membership meetings on the 3rd Monday of each month. So approved.

**Corresponding Secretary:** Ann Hills provided a list of matches received from SCDOC which will be posted to the VHOC Yahoo Group website by Allison Pobirs.

**Training:** (Obedience) Moira Cornell requested purchase of dog toys to be used in her obedience classes. Members offered to donate the toys. She also asked the club to replace her obedience practice jumps which have been used in her classes for many years. These will be donated to the club.

VHOC's Competition Obedience class will offer a 2-hour mini-workshop "With Me" on Monday, June 15, at the CPLS training site with trainer Moira Cornell.

**Publicity:** Christy Tattersall: Nothing new to report.

**Newsette:** Carole Hills brought requests from two members who would like to advertise their training classes in the Newsette. Both requests were denied because of a potential conflict with VHOC's training classes.

**Council:** Laurie Burnam and Allison Pobirs represented the club at the SCDOC meeting on Friday, May 15. Rich Blashford will represent VHOC beginning with the July 2009 SCDOC meeting.

**Old Business:** Michael Fields has agreed to retro-fit the obedience storage units as he did for the agility units.

The purchase of baby gates for the obedience classes was considered; the cost will be investigated and brought back to the Board at a future meeting.

**New Business:** Patti Rovtar inquired as to the existence of club policy regarding use of training tools, specifically of e-collars. The club does not have a policy. Ann Hills presented a summary of other local training clubs' policies; those present discussed whether or not the club should have a policy and what that policy might be. These issues were tabled and will be revisited at the July Board meeting.

Allison Pobirs recommended that the club purchase an additional set of obedience jumps for the Competition Obedience classes. Moira will research the cost and report back.

**Next General Membership Meeting** will be held at 7:00 p.m. on June 22 at the CPLS Training Site with Guest Speaker, Tanya Peel, owner of "All Green Things". The July 13 meeting will also be at CPLS with Larry Warsoff, speaking about AKC regulation changes, including the Optional Titling classes and the new Mixed Breed program.

**Next Board Meeting** will be held at 7:30 pm on June 29 at the home of Ann Hills.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 p.m.

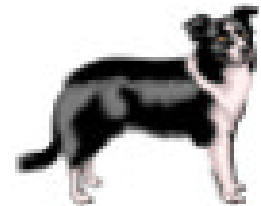
