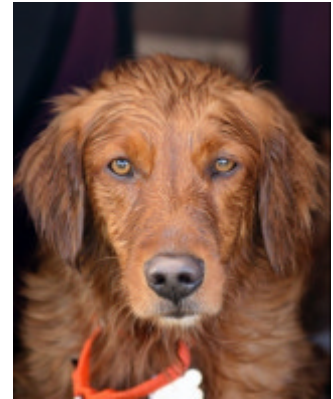
### DOCK DIVING

## VHOC Board Meeting April 27, 2009

The board meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Nancy Giltner. Laurie Burnam, Moira Cornell, Ann Hills, Carole Hills, Allison Pobirs, Patti Rovtar, Christy Tattersall and Linda Zimmerman were in attendance. The Minutes were read and approved, and the Treasurer's report was presented. The Treasurer presented an online survey depicting agility training rates charged by other clubs/training centers and recommended an increase in VHOC's agility rates to keep in tune with the market. The board declined to do so at this time; however a motion was made to increase the trainer's percentage of class fees to 80%. A second motion was made and approved to increase rally fees to \$75 for members and \$90 for non-members. Drop-in rates for obedience and rally will remain at \$15 for members, \$20 for non-members. Drop-in fees for all agility classes were increased to \$20 for members, \$25 for non-members.

**Corresponding Secretary:** Ann Hills discussed an email received from Diane Turner of Old Pueblo Dog Obedience Club of AZ., inquiring how other clubs transition dogs from the puppy class to other classes. Ann explained that we separate our pet classes from our competition classes and that we offer a competition puppy class as a continuous class to prepare dogs and handlers for the beginning competition obedience class. Also, dogs from the pet class often opt to continue with agility or rally classes.

**Publicity:** Christy Tattersall presented an advertising opportunity for VHOC classes: a freebie newsprint magazine, Pet Press, distributed at car washes, vets, pet stores, etc. Moira Cornell moved that we run a 3-month, 1/4 page ad to promote the VHOC pet and rally classes. The motion was seconded and approved. Current promotion offers a 10% discount on the first 3 months, with an additional 10% for a

not-for-profit organization. Christy will negotiate at \$500 for the ad but is prepared to pay the advertised \$680.

**General Membership Meeting Committee:** (Lindia Brown, absent) Planning and locations of General Membership meetings were discussed. Desirable location: one that is large and quiet enough to be able to discuss club business and chat. Tues, Wed and Thurs are out because of club classes. Arrangements can be made for the Canoga Park Lutheran School (CPLS) training site, outdoors in good weather or the gym in colder months—if there are no school events. Check with Moira and consider having the June meeting at CPLS.

**Agility:** (Kim & Terry Simons, absent). Approved Terry's proposal to purchase new style weave poles (12 pole set) at a cost of approximately \$840.

**Old Business:** Website review. Terry Simons has declined to assume the webmaster chair—no time. The position will be offered as a volunteer position to the general membership; additionally, bids will be considered from website professionals. We will still need a committee to organize the redesign, and collect updates and work with the webmaster.

**New Business:** Moira would like to ask Michael Fields to build up the interior of the obedience storage container to maximize available space, and also paint the trial jumps.

**Council:** Laurie Burnam and Allison will attend the meeting on May 21, 2009.

**Next General Membership Meeting** will be held at 7:00 p.m. on May 11, 2009 at Cold Stone Creamery in West Hills.

**Next Board Meeting** will be held on June 1, 2009, 7:00 p.m. at the home of Moira Cornell.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m.

## AKC Announces New Program for Mixed Breeds

[Tuesday, April 14, 2009]

**New York, NY** – For the past 125 years, the American Kennel Club® has been the nation's premier advocate for dogs and the people who love them. The AKC's Board of Directors has voted unanimously to proceed with a program for mixed breed dogs which will allow it to act even more broadly and effectively as the dog's champion. The creation of this program ushers in new opportunities for AKC's constituents and clubs and will allow the organization to grow and flourish.

"Our goal in creating a program specifically designed for mixed breeds is to share our passion for dogs and our sport," said AKC President and CEO Dennis Sprung. "AKC will broaden its legislative influence by representing more dog owners and achieve greater exposure for our responsible dog ownership messaging. But ultimately, the positive developments that this program creates will benefit dogs the most, and this is what we value above all."

The mixed breeds program will be implemented in three phases. As of October 1, 2009 owners can begin enrolling their pets and receive an AKC ID number. Then beginning April 1, 2010 enrolled dogs will be eligible to compete in mixed breed classes at stand-alone AKC Agility, Obedience and Rally events. Soon after they will have access to benefits such as discounted AKC

Companion Animal Recovery Lost and Found service, a free AKC Canine Good Citizen® certificate for dogs passing the CGC test, a free initial veterinary visit, a trial offer of pet health insurance and discounted coupons for dog supplies.

The third phase will offer a dedicated Web site where dog owners can interact via an online community with discussion forums and access dog care video downloads, advice from experts and the most up-to-date news on canine health and welfare. The site will be continually enhanced with new features and benefits in order to respond to the changing needs of pet owners.

This new AKC initiative is the first designed to specifically benefit mixed breed dogs and their dog owners, however the AKC has long included mixed breeds in programs such as AKC Canine Good Citizen®, AKC S.T.A.R. Puppysm, AKC Responsible Dog Ownership Day and the AKC CAR Canine Support and Relief Fund's disaster relief efforts. In addition, AKC has always actively advocated for the rights of all dog owners and the welfare of dogs through its Government Relations efforts and serves dog owners through its affiliate organizations such as the AKC Humane Fund, AKC Canine Health Foundation and AKC Companion Animal Recovery.
