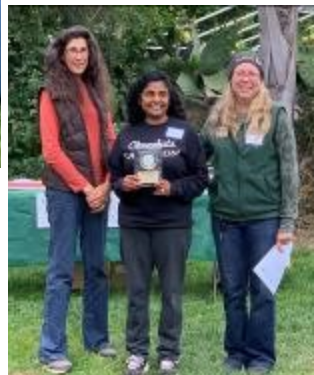

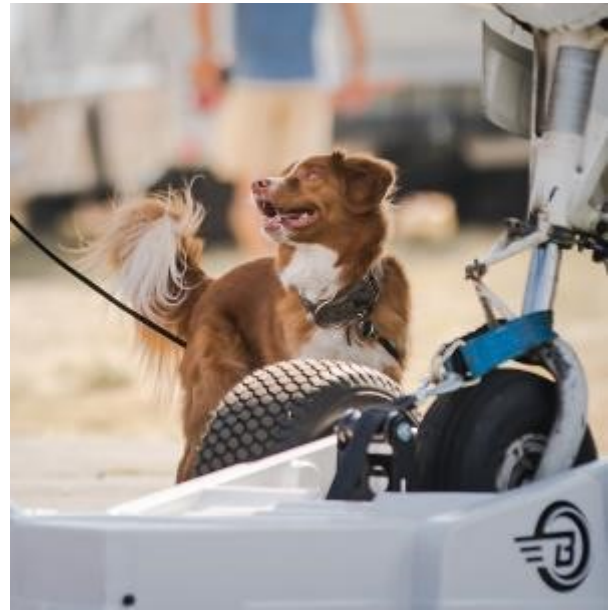

AGILITY TRIAL CHAMPION (ASCA): To earn an ATCH, you must earn 200 points in the Elite Regular class after earning the EAC, and 100 points in both the Elite Jumpers and Elite Gamblers classes after earning those respective Elite titles.

(the point scale is 5 points (score of 91-94), 6 points (score of 95-96), 7 points (score of 97), 8 points (score of 98), 9 points (score of 99), 10 points (score of 100))

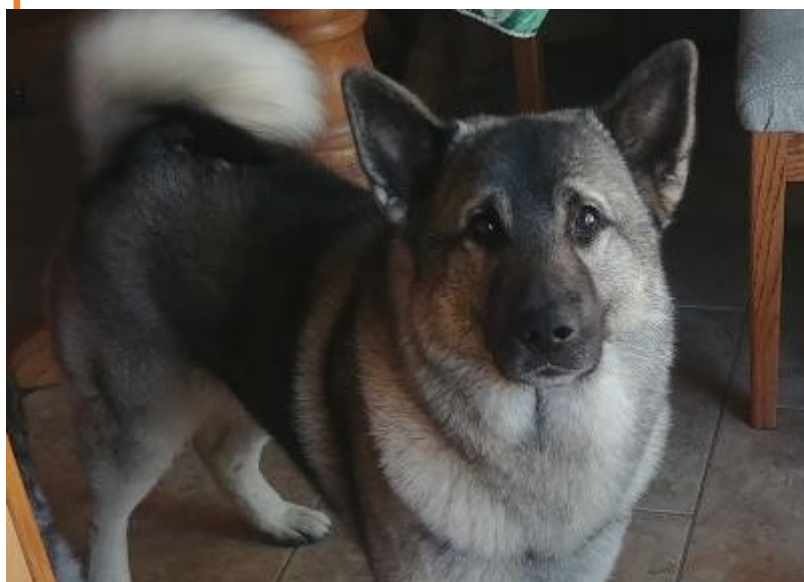

In the event of a tie, handlers may be asked to submit additional data, such as Yards Per Second, or Course Yardage & Dog's Course Time.

SPECIAL AWARDS OFFERED FOR HIGHEST SCORING DOGS

(Qualifying Score Required for All Prizes)

QUALIFYING SCORES are required for "Prizes" for which dogs in one class compete against dogs in one or more other classes at Licensed or Member Trials . . ." (Ch. 1, Sec. 20, Obedience Regulations). Owner or owner's agent **must be present** to receive awards.

The word "dog" shall mean dog or bitch.
